Conditions & Contest Rules

a. All competitions will be conducted under Australian Pipe Bands Association (APBA) Rules

- b. All entries and fees must be received on or before **Monday 18 July 2010**. Please make all cheques payable to the Redland Scottish & Celtic Society Inc.
- c. Competitors may only compete in their registered grades or one grade above. In the event of a large number of entries, the promoters reserve the right to decline entries of competitors entering above their registered grade.
- d. Correct Highland Dress or registered band uniforms must be worn while competing **and also when receiving prizes or trophies**. Pipers accompanying solo drummers must also wear Highland Dress or registered band uniform
- e. There must be at least 3 competitors in each Solo event and 2 in each Band event otherwise the event may be cancelled. If there are fewer than 6 nominations in a solo contest, 1st and 2nd prizes only will be awarded.
- f. Solo competitors are to register with the judge of an event prior to the event commencing
- g. Only fine tuning (maximum 2 minutes) permitted in front of judges in solo competitions
- h. All trophies are to be collected on the day of the competition unless alternative arrangements have been made.
- i. All competitors are to arrange any necessary accommodation and travel.
- j. All competitors compete at their own risk. No liability is accepted for injury or loss sustained by any person taking part in any event.
- k. Entry to all competition events will be at the discretion of the Promoter.
- l. The organisers reserve their right to alter the programme and times as provided in the APBA rules.
- m. All soloists and band persons should endeavour to participate in the Massed Band.
- n. Pipers accompanying solo drummers must wear highland dress or registered band uniform.
